



Bronze and Marble Gueridon Table, 19th Century

Circa: 1880

Breche marble and bronze pedestal table. The oval top is adorned on the rim with an ormolu frieze of leafy interlacing on a midnight-blue background, enlivened by masks as connecting dice. It stands on four slender feet decorated with foliage scrolls on a blue background, and ending in a forked hoof. The legs are joined by an ormolu strut, decorated with pearls and a central medallion with laurel wreath and pinecone. French work from the late 19th century. Cica:1860
