



CHATELAINE IN GOLD, ENAMEL, SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES, MID-19TH CENTURY

Era: Mid-19th century.

Materials: gold, enamel, stone.

Dim: H 3.1 in / W 1.5 in.

Weight: 1.4 oz (40 gr).

Gold mark: owl.

Chatelaine with belt hook in intricately sculpted, matte, pink gold. The piece is topped with a crown featuring pearls and semi-precious stones. Two coats of arms in multicolored enamel are set on gold under the crown, and under the coats of arms is a composition of rinceau, fleur-de-lis, and chains which once held a watch. Mid-19th century French craftsmanship.
