



Charles X white opaline jewellery box

Era: 19th century, Charles X.

Materials: opaline, gilt bronze.

Dim: W 5.9 in / D 3.5 in / H 4.3 in.

Rectangular jewellery box in white opaline and gilt bronze mounts. The chiseled diamond pattern of the box was very popular during the Charles X era. The mounts are engraved with friezes of flowers and flowering branches. The key plate is decorated with cornucopia. Two medallions in the shape of scallop shells adorn the sides. The box rests on four hoof feet that are flanked with foliage. Circa: 1820-1830.
