



19TH CENTURY AUSTRIAN ENAMEL AND SILVER CLOCK

Era: 2nd part of the 19th century.

Materials: enamel, silver.

Dim: H 6.5 in / W 2.8 in / D 2.4 in.

Hallmark A for Austria.

Master goldsmith's hallmark R.B or KB.

Small silver and multicolored enamel clock. It is richly decorated with mythological scenes, people in flowing garments, and Cupids in landscapes. The circular clock face marks the hours in Roman numerals and is surrounded by a lively composition of Cupids. The column-shaped mounting is sculpted with foliage and scrollwork. Each of the four corners of the top of the clock is decorated with a child, and a seated, winged Cupid sits on top of the piece. Viennese work from the second half of the 19th century.

The mechanism is in working order. Watch dial yellowed and teeth missing from the band forming the watch door.
