Rectangular flask in enameled gold. The flask features refined enameling techniques with geometric and floral patterns. The red enamel is translucent, leaving the intricate geometric pattern in the gold underneath visible. The selection of enamel colors is unusual, combining green, pink, opaque white, and translucent red. The end result is reminiscent of vividly colored medieval décor. The hinged lid opens to reveal a gold stopper that seals the flask.
