



Gold and Enamel Box with Miniature on Ivory. Louis XV period.

Round box with gold in several tones and royal blue enamel. The removable lid is decorated with a round miniature on enamel. The monochrome brown miniature features three putti in a landscape who are playing with a laurel garland. The miniature is framed with a frieze of foliage and a chain in gold of two colors. The cover, sides, and base of the box are covered in translucent, royal blue enamel. Each panel is framed in a frieze of foliage that wraps around a chain in two shades of gold. The enamel panels of the sides of the box are interspaced with columns of colored gold ornamented with a frieze of foliage.

Work from the Louis XV period.
