



Gold Snuff Box, Restauration Period

Era: first 19th century, Restauration period.

Materials: gold.

Dim: L 2.8in (7 cm)/ D 1.8in (4,5 cm)/ H 0.4 in (1 cm).

Weight: 1.8 oz (52 g).

Bacchal mask, 1819-1838.

Sphinx in an octagon, 1819-1838.

Master goldsmith mark: C.C.

Rectangular box with rounded corners. The hinged lid as well as the bottom are embellished with an intricate geometric pattern framed with rinceaux motifs on a matte gold background. A button serves to open the box. Circa 1820-1830.
