

Charles X blue opaline crystal flask

Era: 19th century, Charles X.

Materials: opaline.

Dim: H 13,5 cm.

A blue opaline perfume bottle with his ball-shaped stopper. The bottle has a decoration on the body framed by two gold nets. The decor consists of a floral frieze characteristic of the decor of the workshop Desvignes. The independent cap is decorated with golden patterns.

The delicate decoration is typical of Jean-Baptiste Desvignes's 1820's production. During this time, Jean-Baptiste Desvignes found a way to paint on opaline crystal and glass. He used only vegetablebased colors that he affixed to the opaline crystal. The tones, always matte, were limited to dark blue and red. Circa 1820-1830.
