



An EARLY vase with ENAMEL AND GILT DECORATION , HIGH-RELIEF DÉCOR OF MOSER.

Red crystal vase from the Moser crystal factory. The vase rests on one foot. It is decorated with gold-painted motifs representing flowers. Small animals such as dragonflies and butterflies are sprinkled with polychrome enamel. Motifs are in relief as the wave patterns and acorns enhanced with enamel. This vase or glass is characteristic of the production of Moser in Carlsbad Bohemia. Founded in 1857, she produced for all European courts.

This vase is characteristic of the production of the 1880s.
