



**Early 19th century Gold and mother-of-pearl Vinaigrette.**

Rectangular vinaigrette in gold and mother of pearl. The hinged lid is decorated with a monogram E.L. and finely chiseled. The inside of the vinaigrette is entirely lined with gold and opens reveal an openwork grill that is intricately pierced, chiseled and adorned with a flower basket. This grill was used to hold a sponge soaked in vinegar with bergamot or another essence.
