



Gold an enamel case. Early 19th Century.

Rectangular case in translucent blue enamel gold and enhanced with a decoration representing a mill near a bridge. A lying dog looks at the scene. This box, judging by its format, was most likely used as a toiletry accessory. It may have contained tongue scrapers, picks, small brushes, or any other hygiene article in use during the late 18th and early 19th centuries.
