



19th century Viennese clock in enamelled silver

Era: 2nd part of the 19th century.

Materials: enamel, silver.

Dim: H 11,5 cm / W 5 cm.

Dim: H 4.5 in / W 1.96 in.

Rectangular enamelled silver clock with cabochon gemstones. The clock or desk clock is decorated with patterns of foliage and windings. The dial with roman numerals with its pendulum is framed by two figures of the Middle Ages wearing armor and embellished with enamel. An enamelled eagle finishes this composition. The clock rests on four feet. The back of the clock takes the same decorative repertoire of windings. Viennese work. Circa 1870
