

Round tortoiseshell Box with Gold and Erotic Miniature on Ivory

Round box made of powder of tortoiseshell, which imitates porphyry, with a removable lid decorated with a miniature on ivory. The miniature portrays the abduction of lo the nymph by Jupiter. The eagle in the scene is one of Jupiter's symbols. The god, who is coming out of the clouds, is seizing lo, who is nude and in full view. Cupid's arrow has flown. This miniature is reminiscent of a drawing by Fragonard that is conserved at the Musée d'Angers.

The miniature is ringed with a gold mounting and a star motif. The interior of the box is lined with brown tortoiseshell.
