



Early 19th Century curved snuff box

Era: Restauration, 1820.

Materials: gold.

Dim: W 7,5 cm/ D 4,5 cm/ H 1,5 cm.

Weight: 76 g.

Rooster head 1809-1819.

Successive checks: horse head and eagle head.

Goldsmith: D.G

A rectangular snuff box with rounded corners. The box is lightly curved, allowing it to fit comfortably into a pocket. The box is entirely covered with intricately sculpted geometric patterns. Each panel of the box is framed in a frieze of rinceau on a matte gold background. The body and the sides of the box continues the geometric motif. The box has an initial finely engraved in an oval medallion.
