Era: early 19th century.

Materials: wood, gold, ivory.

Dim: diam 2.36in.(6,7cm) / H 0.78in.(2,4 cm).

1er roaster: 1798-1809.

Old man's head 85: 1798-1809, (85 being the number of the department, Paris).

A circular wood gold-mounted box. The removable lid is decorated with a miniature on ivory set in a chased gold frame. The miniature is decorated with a young woman dressed in the antique style and placing flowers on an altar. Cupid at his side attends the scene. Circa 1800-1809.
