



A gold and enamel Business card case. ANDERSON & LEHRS, Londres, 1906

Era: early 20th century.

Materials: gold, enamel.

Dim: W 2.36in.(6,5 cm)/ D 1.57in. (4,8 cm) / H 0.39in.(1,2 cm).

Weight: 4.44oz (126g).

Goldsmith: Anderson & Lehrs London 1906.

A rectangular card case in the Louis XVI style, the hinged cover enamelled in translucent green over a guilloché surrounded with a line in red enamel. A gold floral frieze in "reserve" frames the enamel panel. The center of the lid is decorated with a rectangular panel enamelled in translucent white over a sunburst guilloché ground. The base is in amati gold. The interior is engraved with initials KB and a system allows to hold cards or a notebook. This case was worn hanging from the waist. English gold marks.
