Round gold box in different colours. The independent lid is decorated with a miniature on ivory depicting a mythological scene representing the departure of Roman warriors. The gold surrounding is finely chiseled with foliage patterns in green gold and with a fine cord in yellow gold. The side is decorated with four finely "guilloché" panels alternating with vases with floral composition in coloured gold that stand out on an amati background. The base has a concentric and radiant decoration alternating between guillochage, amati background. A gold coloured foliage motif is at the centre of the composition.
