



Moser Karlsbad bohemian vase, circa 1880

Red crystal vase from the Moser crystal works. The ovoid vase is decorated with gold painted oak leaf motifs. Small dragonflies as well as oak leaves are enhanced with polychrome enamel. Hot-applied acorn motifs are enamelled and gilded in relief. This vase or glass is typical of Moser's production in Karlsbad, Bohemia. Founded in 1857, it produced for all European courts. This vase is characteristic of the production of the 1880s.

Era: 2nd part of the 19th century.

Materials: glass, enamel.
