



Early 19th century gold box. French Restauration.

Rectangular gold box with hinge and rounded edges of the Restauration period. The lid is richly chiseled with floral and foliage motifs surrounding two putti facing each other to lift a monumental urn placed on a pedestal whose tree-like branches run along the base and sides of the box. The sides and the base are decorated with geometric designs interrupted on the side by floral motifs.
