



A gold Powder case signed Boucheron, 1940

Era: 1940-1950.

Materials: gold and diamonds.

Dim: H 6.7 cm / W 9,2 cm/ D 1,4 cm.

Weight: 252,8 gr.

Goldsmith mark: Boucheron paris 875D12 B N.

Hallmark: several eagle heads in hexagon.

Rectangular openwork powder compact very richly chiseled with two interior compartments opening by two hinged plates. These two plates as the lid of the box resume the motifs of the base: a lotus flower radiating by multiplying on the surface of the object. A decoration of lotus flower set with diamonds crowns the lid.
