



Cut crystal and gilt bronze inkwell, Charles X

Era: Charles X (circa 1820)

Materials: gilt bronze, crystal.

Dim: H 12 cm / L 12 cm / P 7 cm.

Dim: H 4,72 cm / L 4,72 cm / P 2,75 cm.

Oval-shaped inkwell resting on four ball-shaped feet, with two cut-crystal cups and gilt-bronze mounting with lattice motifs, one for ink and the other for sand. The central socket is crowned with a laurel wreath. On either side is a vase-shaped penholder. The base is guilloché with streaks and pearls. Some wear to the gilding.
