



Late 19th century, cut-crystal and silver ewer

Cut-crystal ewer with twisting patterns and silver mounts. The collar and the base are decorated with stylized waves, diamonds, and foliage, and a shell adorns the top of the pitcher. Its high, C-shaped handle is embellished with leaves. Monogram A.J on the collar. Second part of the 19th century. Crafted in Paris by the master silversmith, R.B.
