



Mid 19th century English Dance card in gold and enamel

Era: 19th century.

Materials: gold, enamel.

Dim: H 2,95in (7,5cm)/ L 1.37in (3,5 cm)/ D 0,39in (1 cm).

Weight: 2,61 oz (74 gr).

Lion head, leopard (English hallmarks).

Mark of the master goldsmith illegible.

Rectangular dance card in enameled gold. The gold panels are decorated with polychrome flower motifs on a background of opalescent enamel showing a fine work of guillochage. These motifs are framed by foliage leaves left in reserve on a background of translucent blue enamel. The notebook is closed with a gold pencil with a gold lead and a gold nib. Inside, some leaves are preserved and present an almanac in English. Work of the mid-19th century.
