



Early 19th gold and enamel snuffbox

Era: early 19th century

Materials: gold, enamel

Dim: W 6 cm / D 4 cm/ H 1,2 cm

Weight: 1.6 oz (46 g)

Marked with 2 scallops, 14 carats

Early 19th-century wolf's head mark

Master goldsmith: O and lily (incomplete)

Rectangular box with three tones of gold and royal blue enamel. The hinged lid is embellished with a multicolored gold medallion in relief featuring a bouquet of roses and tulips, set on a matte gold background. Delicate foliage accented with royal blue enamel is set around the central medallion. The corners feature floral motifs that echo the central composition. The button that serves to open the box features a shell motif. The sides of the box are ornamented with gold, floral motifs set on a royal blue background. Most likely Swiss craftsmanship.
