Rectangular snuffbox with angled corners in sculpted gold and green enamel. The lid, the border and the bottom of the snuffbox are decorated with guilloche panels. Each panel is framed by a frieze enhanced with a green enamel and carved with stylized floral motifs. This decoration is taken up on the angled corners.

Charge mark: L interlaced 1780-1789.

Discharge mark: soldier's head 1780-1789

Fermier general: Henri Clavel

Check mark: two eagle heads.
