



A 18th Century Gold and enamel snuff box

Era: 18th century.

Materials: gold, enamel.

Dim: W 8,5 cm / D 5,7 cm / H 1,7 cm.

Weight: 104 gr.

Tête d'aigle, 18ct.

Rectangular snuffbox with angled corners in sculpted gold and green enamel. The lid, the border and the bottom of the snuffbox are decorated with guilloché panels. Each panel is framed by a frieze enhanced with a green enamel and carved with stylized floral motifs. This decoration is taken up on the angled corners.
