



Early 19th-century oblong gold and enamel box

Oblong gold and enamel snuff box, the hinged lid and the opening are framed by two matte floral friezes in light relief. On the cover a shield left in reserve allowed the owner to leave his monogram. The snuffbox is decorated with a profusion of foliage in black enamel left in reserve or "taille d'épargne enamel" on a gold background. French work from the early 19th century. Circa 1820-1830.

Some usual wear on the enamel and borders.
