



An early 20th century gold and enamel case

A rectangulaire gold case, with bi-color gold and green translucent enamel. The decoration presents an alternation of gold bands and enamel bands of translucent green color revealing a guilloché. The box reveals three compartments. Each part is framed by a frieze of white enamel and has thumpiece set with diamonds. The main compartment is adorned with a circular A.S monogram set with diamonds.

Work from the beginning of the 20th century probably for the Russian market. Circa 1920.

Era: first 19th century.

Materials: gold, enamel.

Weight: 187gr with the mirror.

Punch: Owls
