



Early 19th century silver and crystal candy dish, swan and dolphin

Drageoir or candy dish in silver and crystal cut called "diamond tip" slightly flared. The collar is openwork and presents a decoration of palmette. The body of the drageoir is decorated with dolphin motifs backed by a palmette motif surmounted by a shell. Two handles decorated with foliage ending in a nest and birds. The lid is of a round swan forming the finial. The drageoir rests on a pedestal and a quadrangular base ending in four ball feet. We can form a pair with a similar drageoir.

Era: Early 19th century.

Materials: crystal, silver.

Dim: H 11.02in. (28 cm) / W 6.67in. (19.5 cm).

Weight: 550g (without glass)

Silver mark ET for foreign work (Germany).

Fleur-de-lys crowned.
