

Late 19th century pair of ewers in crystal and silver, Labat & Pugibet Era: Mid 19th century.

Materials: crystal, silver.

Dim: H 11,02in/ (28cm).

Silver mark: Minerva from 1838.

Silversmith: Labat and Pugibet, Henin successor.

A pair of ewers or wine carafes in blown and cut crystal with torso motifs, silver mountings. The neck and base of the ewer are decorated with floral and foliage motifs. The spout and the lid are decorated with shells. The serpentine handle is decorated with scrolls and asymmetrical decorative motifs. Work of the second part of the 19th century. Circa 1880.
