A milk-crystal plate decorated with dark blue forget-me-not and gilded stripes realized by Jean Baptist Desvignes. French painter on glass, crystal and porcelain, Desvignes became famous for painting the opal crystal and glass with vegetable colours, especially dark blue and red. Light wear to the gilding.
