

Early 19th century enamelled bracelet

Era: first 19th century. (1820)

Materials: pompone, enamel.

Dim: 6.29in. (16 cm).

Weight: 1.23oz (35 g).

Bracelet in "pomponne" with black and white enamel. The bracelet is composed of eight diamondshaped medallions with alternating decorations: golden palmettes on a black and white enamel background and openwork palmettes with a flower design in the centre enhanced with black enamel. The bracelet has a ratchet clasp. Some wear. This bracelet is characteristic of the Restoration period.
