



Early 19th century bonbonniere with miniature

Round box in gray composite material (plundered fish scales, binder and pigments) lined on the inside with brown tortoiseshell. The removable lid features a miniature on ivory depicting a young woman in an undergrowth. She is wearing a blue checkered dress belted at the waist with a ribbon; a red shawl covers her shoulders. She wears a white headdress.

Early 19th century foreign work, probably Dutch .

Era: early 19th century.

Materials: ivory, tortoiseshell, composite material.

Dim: diam 7,5 cm / H 2 cm.
