Large Restauration-period gilt bronze centerpiece resting on four feet adorned with scrolls and stylized petals. The mirror-covered oval base is hemmed with an openwork frieze, finely chased with foliate scrolls embellished with flowers, seeds and ears of wheat, surmounted by a laurel wreath. Very fine chasing and fine detailing. A few rust stains on the mirror.
