



Gilt bronze and blue glass nightlight, Restoration period

A gilt bronze lantern-shaped nightlight with a blue glass container holding the candle, a source of light in the 19th century. It consists of a square base surmounted by a canted pilaster that continues into a fluted column. A ram's head rests on the column, and a branch curls forward to hold the blue glass in place with three chains.

Period: Restoration.

Materials: gilt bronze, glass.
