



Green opaline pair of flasks, 19th century

Era: 19th century.

Materials: opaline.

Dim: H 24 cm/ Diam (plate) 15 cm.

Collection Cabos.

A pair of green opaline perfume flasks with their sharp corks, decorated with diamond-shaped patterns and gilded striped. The collar whose interior is painted with gold, is heightened with gilded binding. The two flasks are in good condition, as well as their flower-shaped saucers. Circa 1850.

A stopper cannot be removed. Light wear to the gilding.
