IGRC goldsmith's hallmark for **Georges Remond et Compagnie** active in Geneva between 1783 and 1815/1820. Hallmark G in a cartouche for Genève; Hallmark P.3. G in an oval (worn) for Genève 1814

This type of flat-wheel mechanism with pins and hands is similar to the work of Daniel Isaac Piguet and Philippe Samuel Meylan, who worked in Geneva from 1811 to 1828 with J.G Remond.
