



Longwy plate, swan décor, late 19th century

Era: 19th century.

Materials: faence.

Dim: diam 9 in / H 1.18 in.

Signed: Longwy.

Artist initials: BR and FF.

A Longwy poly-lobed plate formed of three concentric circles. The black background is decorated with foliage interspersed with pairs of swans separated by a vase of flowers. The base of the dish is decorated with alternating motifs of leaves and flowers in bright colours. The central medallion depicts a flower in full bloom. All the motifs are underlined by hand-painted black fillets.

Engraved Longwy signature and FF initials.

Heaume mark circa 1880 until the end of the 19th century.

Artist BR, 1877 painted with enamel.
