



Gold and diamond Koran pendant, 19th century

Era: XIX century.

Materials: gold, diamonds, enamel.

Dim: H 3,8 cm / W 3,5 cm / D 0,9 cm.

Weight: 30 g.

Hallmark: Horse head, from 1838.

Two owl.

A very fine 18 carat gold Ottoman Qur'an holder consisting of a two-sided book, one side centred with fine diamonds bearing the inscription Allah in a superimposed surround of low-cut Islamic motifs.

The other side, entirely pierced and surrounded by interlaced motifs, is centred with the inscription Allah in small diamonds in a low-cut enamel surround bordering a central white ring. The hoop is in the same style. From the Fitz-James collection.
