



Painting charge of the French cuirassiers at Watreloo signed Eugène Charpentier

Era: middle19th century.

Historical painting representing the French cuirassiers charging on the British squares during the battle of Waterloo. Beautiful gilded wood frame from the period. Signed **Eugène Louis Charpentier** (1811-1890).

A pupil of François Gérard and Léon Cogniet, he is best known for his battle scenes, most of which are kept at the Château de Versailles. He also painted portraits, the most famous of which is that of George Sand (1839). He died in Paris in 1890 and is buried in the Montparnasse cemetery.
