



Late 19th century English table casket with mother-of-pearl inlay and its inkstand

Era: XIX century.

Materials: papier mâché, mother in pearl.

A surprising late 19th century table casket with mother-of-pearl-inlay and painted floral decoration. Two oval medallions with bunches of flowers and scrolls decorate the main face of this casket. It opens by two lateral doors. The interior is composed of a central niche and eight drawers provided with carved shell drawer pulls. One of the drawers forms inkstand. It is composed of a large receptacle for feathers and a tray covered with dark purple velvet and gilded rinceau. English work, signed Patent. Minor restorations and wear.
