



Gold, pearl and diamond necklace, French work circa 1900

Era: first 19th century, Art Nouveau

Materials: gold, pearl, diamond

Hallmark: Eagle head, 18 carat

Elegant necklace in 18 carat yellow gold adorned with delicate falling plant motifs forming three stylised bouquets of flowers held by the central chain and ending in a fine pearl pendant. Each heart of the flowers holds a small rose-cut diamond. The double chain structure subtly emphasises the décolleté, playing on the gentle asymmetry and rhythm of the ornaments.

A testament to the jewellery-making expertise of the Belle Époque, this jewel combines naturalistic grace with precious sophistication. Ideal for a ceremony or to enhance an elegant outfit, it embodies the romantic poetry of French haute joaillerie at the end of the 19th century.
