Diamond-shaped workshop punch

The hinged cap features a central motif of a child seated in a niche, surmounted by a mascaron and surrounded by flowers in relief, foliage and rocaille motifs characteristic of the Louis XV style. The upper part of the neck features on either side a vase pouring water like a spring, surrounded by foliage and scrolls. The base of the bottle also features floral decorations in relief and a gadrooned base adorned with a rose. Napoleon 3.

Silver hallmark: boar's head from 1838.

Diamond-shaped workshop punch.
