Goldsmith's hallmark: Jean Fremin (1714-1786)

Harrow and shell discharge hallmark for 1756-1762.

Jurande T hallmark for 1759.

Rectangular snuffbox with its four gold hinged lid, decorated on all sides with butterfly flowers and bees gathering on a radiant background in scrolled cartouches. France, early second half of the 18th century.

Goldsmith's hallmark: Jean Fremin (1714-1786) received master in 1738.

Harrow and shell discharge hallmark for 1756-1762.

Jurande T hallmark for 1759.

The workshop, which specialised in snuffboxes in various shades, was located on the Pont au Change after several other addresses. He retired in 1783.
